# Squared Away Rainbow Sconce

## SQUARED AWAY – Rainbow Sconce



### Materials needed:

4 pieces 1 ½ inch square OGT 151 Red glass  
4 pieces 1 ½ inch square OGT 171 Orange glass  
4 pieces 1 ½ inch square OGT 161 Yellow glass  
4 pieces 1 ½ inch square OGT 123 Medium Green glass  
4 pieces 1 ½ inch square WIS 96-16 Sapphire Blue glass  
4 pieces 1 ½ inch square OGT 146 Dark Purple  
38 pieces ½ inch square OGT 200 White Opal glass.

Rainbows are always pretty. I thought it would be fun to make a squared away rainbow sconce.

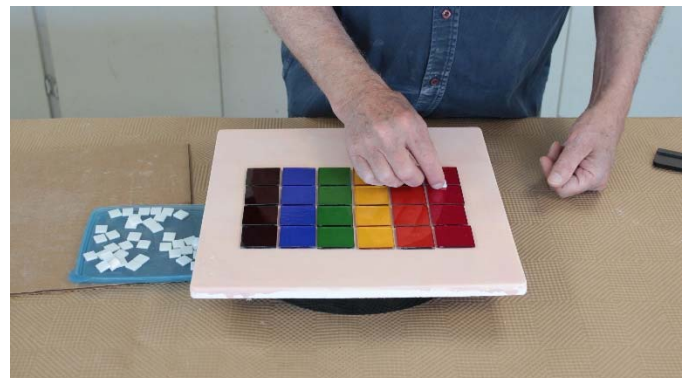
Set out the first row with one of each of the 6 colored squares with about 1/8" space between each square. I building the project on a kiln shelf on my work table. When it's finished, I'll carry the shelf to the kiln but, if you prefer, you could build your project inside the kiln.



With the 4 rows of each of the different colors set out, use a straight edge to line them up.



Start placing the small ½ inch white squares at the middle of each square to act as bridges to connect all the colored squares.





## Squared Away Rainbow Sconce

I put them on a little sloppy here. No worries. I'll straighten everything out when it's in the kiln.



Fix the position of all the squares before firing. Here I'm using a dental pick. I like these for moving glass around on a kiln shelf.
