


## Abstract Flames

This is a great abstract piece done by Caleb, (age 16) using our NT and Artisan colors and one piece of 6" x 8" glass. This piece was left uncapped so instead of the Artisans creating bubbles, there was great texture which shows up two different ways. The photo on the left is on an opaque surface and the one on the right is backlit. Two very different looks to the same piece.

Products used: NT Colors—11002 Tomato and 11004 Pumpkin. Artisan Color—607 Mystic Blue. Mix colors to consistency of melted ice cream.

**Directions:** Wet the surface of the glass with water. Begin by drizzling Tomato in a random manner across the glass using a craft stick as the applicator. Repeat with Mystic Blue. Repeat with Pumpkin but go in a circular motion this time. Repeat the circular motion with the other two colors. Tilt the glass, allowing the colors to run into one another until you like the look. Could also let the colors run in different directions. For different effects.

Firing schedule: This was done on 6mm float glass so the firing schedule is for float. Fire your piece according to the glass YOU are using. UGC Glass Separator and FREE were used on the kiln shelf and the piece was fired directly on the kiln shelf.

Four segments: 1) 450/1480/10 **2)** AFAP/1000/10 **3)** AFAP/850/20 **4)** AFAP/300/1 Allow to cool to room temperature.
